He initiated the foundation of the Mayday Heartbeat Appeal for the generation of funds for the redevelopment of the cardiac unit at Mayday University Hospital. He served on several hospital and regional committees and is the author of papers on Clinical Cardiology, Cardiac Pacing and Nuclear Cardiology. His main research interests have lain in the field of cardiac pacemakers. He has written several texts on cardiology for patients and paramedical staff, many now available on the web at www.surgerydoor.co.uk
